## Scholarship Criteria (*Student Copy*)

The following scholarships are available TO ALL MAYFIELD HIGH SCHOOL SENIORS. Please read all the requirements as many of our scholarships have similar qualifications. Once your application is submitted, our committee will match your qualifications to each scholarship criteria. Unless specifically noted differently in any of the scholarship funds listed below, students must have a minimum 2.5 GPA or higher to apply for any of these scholarships.

- 1. The Ancestry Scholarship:** is awarded to multiple students pursuing a post-secondary education program at a two or four-year school or a trade/technical school. Students must have at least one Mayfield High School parent, step-parent, or grandparent who graduated from Mayfield. Criteria also includes financial need and involvement in extracurricular activities. (1981)
- 2. The John Szuhay Memorial Theater Scholarship:** is awarded to a student who has been active in Thespians and Mayfield Players.
- 3. The Ron Ritner Memorial Scholarship:** is awarded to a student who has been active in sports. The criteria include at least one varsity letter.
- 4. The Alvarez Fine Arts Scholarship:** is awarded to a student planning to continue education in the field of fine arts where creativity and use of the hands is paramount. Working with the hands can also mean construction trades, graphics, computer design or other manual labor.
- 5. The Tim Collaros Memorial Scholarship:** is awarded to a student who has been active in sports. Criteria includes at least one varsity letter.
- 6. The Michael Patrick Colombi Memorial Scholarship:** is awarded to a student who has lettered in a sport and achieved high academic excellence.
- 7. The Norman Huelsman Memorial Scholarship:** is awarded to a student who is planning a career in the field of education.
- 8. The William Shaylor Memorial Scholarship:** is awarded to a student who has attended Mayfield at least three years and whose activities and attitude made an impact on the school.
- 9. The Butch Woodie Memorial Scholarship:** is awarded to a student who has been active in sports. The criteria include at least one varsity letter.
- 10. The Rich Vojticek Memorial Scholarship:** is awarded to a student who has been active in sports. Criteria include at least one varsity letter and an above average pursuit of volunteerism.
- 11. The Harvey Scheetz Memorial Scholarship:** is awarded to a student who has been active in sports. The criteria include at least one varsity letter. The applicant must be college bound with the intention of majoring in education or entering a field connected to the sciences.
- 12. The Paul Gadke Memorial Scholarship:** is awarded to a student who has been active in sports with at least one varsity letter and an above average involvement with school clubs and activities.

- 13. The Nancy West Business Scholarship:** is awarded to a student who is planning to pursue a career in business. Criteria includes an intent to major in business and a very strong work ethic
- 14. The Judy Delfs Spirit Scholarship:** is awarded to a student who has demonstrated exemplary spirit and involvement in school clubs and activities
- 15. The Edward S. Ferris Memorial Scholarship:** is awarded to a student who has lettered in at least one sport. This scholarship is open to a male or female athlete with consideration given to a participant in wrestling.
- 16. The John DeLauro Memorial Scholarship:** is awarded to a student who has earned at least one varsity athletic letter and has plans to enter the field of business.
- 17. The Kim Grootegoed Soeder Nursing Scholarship:** is awarded to a student who has chosen to continue his/her education in the field of nursing and has shown a commitment to participating in community service during high school.
- 18. Wayne & Anna Farinacci Leadership Scholarship:** is awarded to a student who demonstrated the qualities of leadership, service and commitment to teams, offices, or clubs during the student's high school career. While this student must be highly involved in student offerings, he/she must also maintain the ability to influence his peers in a positive manner.
- 19. "Little Joe" Micale Literary Scholarship:** is awarded to a student who has achieved specific literary accomplishments or plans to pursue a literary career. It is designed to encourage and help support a student who seeks a writing career.
- 20. The Tex Collaros Memorial Scholarship:** is awarded to a student who has been active in sports. Criteria includes at least one varsity letter.
- 21. The Andrew Revello Memorial Scholarship:** is awarded to a student who has been a two-sport athlete and is preferably pursuing a business degree in college.
- 22. The Sandy Turner Community Service Scholarship:** is awarded to a student who has obtained an impressive record of community service throughout his/her school career, with a strong emphasis on service hours completed for organizations outside of high school. This may include churches, hospitals, Red Cross, etc.
- 23. The Gene "Dutch" Schmidt Memorial Scholarship:** is awarded to a student who has been active in sports. This student must also be driven by education and leadership with a focus on Sports Management/Teaching.
- 24. The Herman Treu Band Scholarship** is awarded to a student who obtained a high level of achievement while playing in the band during high school.
- 25. The Mary Jane Reed/Jean Zasio English and Journalism Scholarship** is awarded to a student who has earned an A average grade in English throughout high school. Emphasis is placed on the student's creativity, attention to detail and passion for the English language and its applications. The student will have applied or been admitted to a university to major in English or Journalism.
- 26. The Carl Roth Scholarship** is awarded to a student who has excelled in the field of Political Science. The candidate should show involvement in relevant MHS clubs (i.e. World Affairs Club) and has volunteered in the community, ideally with work in an immigrant community. The student will demonstrate interest in pursuing a career in some branch of political science or international studies that promotes cultural understanding.

- 27. The Garber Family Scholarship:** is awarded to a student who is interested in entrepreneurship. Preference will be given to a student who shows enterprising spirit, whether through involvement in school and community organizations or real-world experience in starting a company.
- 28. The Sloe Family Scholarship:** is awarded a student who has demonstrated community/church/school service involvement and has an entrepreneurial spirit. This scholarship is open to a student that may be heading to college or furthering their education in the Skilled Trades.
- 29. The Emily & Arch McCartney Family Scholarship:** is awarded to a student in the amount of \$1,000 who will be attending a state university within Ohio. This scholarship is unique in that it will be renewed for three additional years provided the student maintains a 3.0 GPA and continues to attend a state university.
- 30. The Marella Family Student-Athlete Engineering Scholarship:** is awarded to a student-athlete in the amount of \$500 who has demonstrated an aptitude in both a mathematics & science curriculum and in athletics. The student's desire is to pursue a career in engineering or applied sciences.
