## REUNION COMMITTEE MEETING HUGE SUCCESS

The Alumni Association invited all reunion committee chairpersons to a meeting on January 11, 2005. The purpose of the meeting was to share successes and pitfalls that any reunion committee faces when planning for a well organized, highly attended, and economically affordable class reunion. The reunion committee chairpersons were encouraged to invite a few others from their committees in order to generate fruitful discussion. Over twenty classes and fifty graduates attended the meeting held at Mayfield High School.

There were three major goals for the participants:

1. To share information (experience) regarding the reunions we have planned in the past.
2. To learn about the class reunion services the Alumni Association provides (see p.12).
3. To discuss the concept of several classes pooling resources for a common reunion.

Several members of the Executive Board were on hand to provide direction and assistance. The Association collected written input from the participants to add to the data already on file from the last 49 class reunions conducted by classes from the late 1930's to the mid 1990's. From all the information generated, the following outcomes were revealed:

**The last 49 Mayfield class reunions were held during the months of -**

May-1, June-2, July-6, August-13, September-10, October-2, November-15

**Each class' opinion as to the appropriate amount of money to charge per person for Sat. night of the reunion - \$20 - 0, \$30 - 1, \$40 - 3, \$50 - 9, \$60 - 5, \$70 - 1, \$80 - 0**

**In answer to "What format will your class choose for your next class reunion?"**

Sat. only - 3 Fri. & Sat. - 11 Sat. & Sun. - 4 Fri., Sat., & Sun. - 3

**What are the most difficult tasks or problems a reunion committee has to deal with?**

Locating classmates - 13	Determining costs - 7
Finding a suitable location - 6	Forming a <u>working</u> committee - 5
Trying to please everyone - 5	Getting enough classmates to attend - 5
Determining a date - 4	Amount of work to make it worthwhile - 3
Working within a budget - 3	Money down out of pocket - 2
Securing contracts - 2	Determining food - 2
Obtaining entertainment - 2	Cash or open bar - 1
Getting info. for memory book - 1	Treasurer completing final report - 1
Input from classmates regarding preferences - 1	Planning activities - 1

### 2004 Hall of Fame Inductees

Carrie Jackson, food service, and Harriet Bush, Gifted Education, were inducted into the Alumni Staff Hall of Fame in November. Also inducted was the late Edward Siebenhar, Music and English Departments.



This past November, the Alumni Association conducted its 24th annual **Reverse Raffle/Staff Hall of Fame Induction** at the Normandy Party Center in Wickliffe. The Staff Hall of Fame, in its fifth year, is a focal point of the raffle. The raffle itself is the Association's major fundraiser. A Silent Auction runs concurrently with the raffle. Participants bid on such items as a condo at Indian Harbour, Florida; a suite at the Glidden House with dinner at Sergio's and four tickets to the Cleveland Playhouse; Gift Basket from the Loretta Paganini School of Cooking; Afghan & Champagne Basket; three foursomes of golf at Grantwood Golf Course; and an engraved Cleveland Browns wine bottle and foursome of golf. The Association would like to thank all the donors and those responsible for obtaining the auction items.

Once again, **Sandy ('61) and Linda Carmigiano**, owners of the **Normandy Party Center**, provided a tasteful all-you-can-eat family style dinner. Their food always receives the highest praise. **Tony ('53) and Carol Leonardi**, also known as **Rhythm Connection**, did an outstanding job of keeping everyone on the dance floor. The **Staff Hall of Fame** induction took place at the raffle and once again inductees were impacted by the tremendous reception they received. They felt a genuine sense of appreciation for all they had given in the past to the Mayfield student body. Inductees this year were **Edward Siebenhar, Harriet Bush, and Carrie Jackson**.

**Ed Siebenhar**, now deceased, was Director of Music for 13 years and English Department Chairperson for 22 years at Mayfield High School. He started at Mayfield in 1937 and retired in 1972.

**Harriet Bush** began her teaching career at Millridge Center for the Hearing Impaired in 1971 as a resource teacher. She continued to teach at Millridge in 3rd and 4th grade classes until she was asked to lead and implement a gifted program at Mayfield Middle School. When the Middle School closed in 1984, the gifted program moved to the high school where Harriet continued to meet with students on an individual and small group basis. Harriet retired from Mayfield in 1995 and continued as the State Director of the Academic Decathlon until 1998.

**Carrie Jackson** moved to Mayfield in 1942 and that September entered the 7th grade. She was a cheerleader until her graduation in 1948. Carrie worked in food service from 1967 until 1987. Carrie loved her job, was great with the students, and even served as historian on the Alumni Executive Board from 1984 to 1993.
