Mayfield Alumni Association Honors Bob Baker

“Mr. Good Guy” is mourned—Mayfield family loses one of it’s best. **Bob Baker**, Mayfield School District Treasurer for 28 years, died August 4, 2005, following surgery in a Virginia hospital for head injuries suffered in a bicycle accident. The mishap occurred while he was vacationing in that state with his wife, Janis.

Bob has won several state and national awards for his work and was known as “one of the best school treasurers in the state.” Those who worked with him realized he was the only person they knew who could make school finance understandable. He has been given credit for humanizing a lot of difficult processes, such as budgeting and negotiations. People trusted anything Bob said. He was one of the most sincere and honest people anyone knew.

As a tribute to Bob Baker, the Mayfield School District named the Administration Building after him. A beautiful new sign was unveiled at a touching ceremony in October. The Alumni Association presented a plaque to Superintendent Phillip Price to commemorate the building. The plaque resides in the entranceway of the Administration Building next to a framed painting of Bob which was painted by high school art teacher **Jim Gerard**.

A crowd of over 300, including the Class of '65 Reunion, hung around until the wee hours of the morning. This year's Staff Hall of Fame inductees were from Mayfield High School, the Central Office, and Millridge Elementary. The raffle itself is the Association's major fundraiser. A Silent Auction runs concurrently with the raffle. This year we were fortunate to have two condo's (in Florida and Myrtle Beach) and a vacation house in the Smokey Mountains to bid on. Participants also pursued a suite at the Glidden House Inn with dinner at Sergio's, Stanley Steamer Basket, Afghan, Wine & Chocolate Basket; Wines of the World Basket, foursomes of golf with carts at Grantwood Golf Course; and engraved Cleveland Cavaliers wine bottles. The Association would like to thank all the donors and those responsible for obtaining the auction items.

Once again, **Sandy ('61) and Linda Carmigiano**, owners of the **Normandy Party Center**, provided a tasteful all-you-can-eat family style dinner. Their food always receives the highest praise. **Tony ('53) and Carol Leonardi**, also known as **Rhythm Connection**, did an outstanding job of keeping everyone on the dance floor. To conserve on time, the Association did not "reverse" the raffle this year. Instead, the last five numbers were pulled at the beginning of the raffle. Also, the Association decided to minimize the induction ceremony by providing a program that detailed each inductee's contributions to the Mayfield Schools. This provided more time to talk directly with the inductees. They felt a genuine sense of appreciation for all they had given in the past to the Mayfield student body.

Inductees this year were **Kay Del Brocco, Mary Grootegoed, Lou Ramicone and Paul Sabatino**. **Kay Del Brocco** split her career at the Middle School and Millridge Elementary. She shared a sense of family with the staff at both schools. Kay retired in 1998 with memories to last a lifetime. **Mary Grootegoed** served as Director of Adult Education where, during her tenure, the growth of class offerings rose from 50 to 220! Mary retired in 1991 with 21 years of service to the Mayfield Schools and loved every minute of it. **Lou Ramicone's** career began in 1946 when he was hired to teach history and Spanish. He taught for 39 years, retiring in 1979. Lou was a favorite of the students and had the 1961 Senior Book dedicated to him as well as the 1963 Mayfielder and the 1979 Senior Book. His career included a Fullbright Scholarship in 1959 to study in Turin, Italy. He was also a Jennings Scholar in 1965. Lou passed away in 1999. **Paul Sabatino** taught, coached, and served as an administrator in Mayfield for 36 years. Paul was the recipient of the Martha Holden Jennings Administrative Leadership Award in 1978. Paul Sabatino has the distinction of being the only person to substitute, teach, serve as an administrator and be elected to the School Board in Mayfield.

MAYFIELD, THEN AND NOW....

The era coming into focus has been dubbed The Fabulous Fifties. The decade's name is looked upon as appropriate by many who were teenagers carousing the halls of Mayfield High School, located on S.O.M. Center Rd., hosting grades 7 thru 12.

Our country experienced very little inflation in the '50's, as did Mayfield Heights and surrounding communities. A decent home cost 13 - 15 thousand dollars. Some even less. Most new cars could be bought for under \$2,000.00. General Dwight D. Eisenhower, Supreme Allied Commander during World War II, was President from '52 through '60. Most people felt that a very competent man was in the White House, especially with a new type of conflict heating up called The Cold War.

Teenagers of the era had it made. We bought cars of the '20's, '30's and '40's and turned them into Jalopies or Hot Rods, often chopped, often sporting a modern V-8 engine boasting 300-400 horsepower, hydraulic breaks and 4/11 rear-ends that could blow by everything but a squad car. Eh, we could wipe the cops, no problem, till we ran out of gas (25 cents a gallon!) or drove into a roadblock. Wasn't worth it, really.

Mayfield Road, from City Hall/ Police / Fire Station, all the way to S.O.M. Center Road was trees galore; hardly any buildings, certainly no car dealers or slow or fast-food places. Of course there was Charkies, a drive-in burger 'n hotdog joint catering to teen customers. It was located the other way, just west of Lander Rd., across from The Mayland Theater. That was pretty much IT, but we rated it as G R E A T, especially after a game or other school event.

Mayfield High School's principal, Mr. Lackey, was a verbal man with only a ring of hair. He was referred to as Chrome Dome, but never addressed as such to his face. He took complete responsibility for Mayfield. It was his turf. Many of us misunderstood him, at least for a time, but by and large we came to appreciate his heavy fist.

Theron S. Gurney was Mr. Lackey's ass kicker. He ran "Mr. Gurney's College for Resisters of Knowledge." Seriously, in an era when corporal punishment was still in vogue, I don't remember either of those talk-tough, talk-soft guys raising a hand to anyone. I definitely remember that more than a few of us could have been prime candidates for a swift kick now and then.

Today Stuff

January 21, 2006 will forever be known as a gathering of "A Pride of Wildcats," a Mayfield Happening in, would you believe, Southwest Florida!
