Harvey Scheetz Memorial Scholarship Started

At the Association's last Raffle/Staff Hall of Fame Induction in November, one of the new inductees was **Harvey Scheetz** (see article). Mr. Scheetz had a tremendous impact on many students, but one special student in particular. His name is **Al (Bert) Jenkins, Class of '40**. Al graduated from Mayfield in 1940 having captained the football, basketball and baseball teams. Al was also a fine student in the classroom. One day in April, Mr. Scheetz, then the principal of MHS, asked Al where he was going to college. Al answered, "There is no way I could afford college." Mr. Scheetz then told Al that something had to be done about that. A few days later Mr. Scheetz drove Al to Kenyon College where, after testing and interviewing, Al was awarded a full scholarship.

Al has never been able to appropriately thank Mr. Scheetz for this "over the top" favor he had done for Al. Until now, that is. Al has donated a check for \$10,000 to start the Harvey Scheetz Memorial Scholarship! When contacted by Al, **President Wayne Farinacci** expressed his gratitude for the donation and told Al, "There is no better way to thank Mr. Scheetz than by giving him the opportunity to further impact today's students as well. He would be very proud of what you have accomplished."

Al sent a note to the Association along with his check and wrote, "Establishing the Harvey Scheetz Memorial Scholarship is my belated effort to say 'Thank you for a wonderful life'."

The first Harvey Scheetz Memorial Scholarship in the amount of \$1,000 will be awarded this Honors Day, May 25, 2007.

Alumni Association Reaches Back for Staff Hall of Fame Inductees — Bill Hunt, Frank Russell and Harvey Scheetz

The Mayfield Alumni Association conducted its 26th annual **Raffle/Staff Hall of Fame Induction** at the Normandy Party Center in Wickliffe in November. This year's Staff Hall of Fame inductees were from Mayfield High School and the Central Office. The raffle itself is the Association's major fundraiser. A Silent Auction runs concurrently with the raffle. The Association would like to thank all the donors and those responsible for obtaining the auction items.

Once again, **Sandy ('61) and Linda Carmigiano**, owners of the **Normandy Party Center**, provided a tasteful all-you-can-eat family style dinner. Their food always receives the highest praise. **Tony ('53) and Carol Leonardi**, also known as **Rhythm Connection**, did an outstanding job of keeping everyone on the dance floor. Inductees this year were **Bill Hunt, Frank Russell, and Harvey Scheetz**.

Bill Hunt was a member of the Mayfield High School Mathematics Department for 30 years, serving as department chairman for many of those years. Bill then became the school district's first Director of Technology. He received awards from the Ohio Council of Teachers of Mathematics and the National Council of Teachers of Mathematics for inspiration and devotion to mathematics education. After retirement, Bill continued his involvement in mathematics as a consultant for multiple projects for Public Television and worked on projects for the Ohio Department of Education. Bill served as president of several Ohio organizations with ties to mathematics and also was co-editor of the *Ohio Proficiency Guide for the 9th Grade Proficiency Test* and the *Ohio High School Exit Exam*. Bill was nominated for the Staff Hall of Fame by a former student, **Greg Pfenninger, Class of '66**, who described Bill as "patient beyond belief, coaching, encouraging and cultivating a scared, timid pupil lacking in confidence toward becoming a solid math student, inspiring the belief that teaching was a worthy goal in life!" This former student became a teacher and charged his students with passing along what his math teacher gave to him: *Reach out to others giving your time and expertise with tender, cajoling and demanding expectations. Always build confidence while cultivating their ability to learn, grow, and mature.*

Frank Russell began his 42-year career with the Mayfield Schools in 1934, earning \$1,400 a year and over the years taught mathematics, mechanical drawing, blue print reading and driver education. In addition, he coached junior and senior high football, basketball and baseball. Frank also served as Athletic Director for several years. The last eight years of his career in Mayfield were spent as the Business Manager for the school system. Frank and Nellie Russell were married in 1938 and had two sons, Jim and Bill, who both graduated from Mayfield and represented their father at the induction. There was a \$300 difference in salary rates for women in those early years, and once Frank and Nellie got married she lost her job because at that time a married woman wasn't supposed to teach!! Nellie later received a job at the high school and taught mathematics for 25 years. When interviewed prior to retirement, Frank said, "If I had to do it over again, I would do everything the same way." Frank and Nellie both retired in 1976. Frank passed away in April, 1984.

Harvey Scheetz began his career at Mayfield as a teacher and coach. He taught and coached just about everything from industrial arts and mathematics to boys basketball, girls basketball and baseball. In 1936 his baseball team won the state championship. He was named principal of Mayfield High School in the late thirties and in 1945 he was promoted to the position of Superintendent. Harvey was largely responsible for the construction of the current high school building on Wilson Mills Rd. His constant stewardship of the school system from 1945 until his retirement in 1966 built the strong foundation which it has enjoyed throughout the twentieth century and into the twenty first. The list of prominent Mayfield faculty members who were hired by Harvey Scheetz includes Rick Miner, Dutch Schmidt, Bill Shaylor, Herman Treu, Ed Andrews, Ed Ferris, Mary Grootegoed, Lou Ramicone, Paul Sabatino, Ed Seibenhar, Gerry Beach, and Jean Zasio, all of whom have been inducted into the Mayfield Alumni Association's Staff Hall of Fame. Harvey's son, Robert, was a 1950 graduate of Mayfield High School and represented his father at the induction.

Staff Hall of Fame inductees receive an alabaster apple on a black marble base with an inscribed plate that includes the specifics of their induction. In addition, their names are inscribed on a plaque that is displayed at the high school. The plaque for high school honorees is at the foot of the steps leading up to the gym and auditorium. The middle school and each elementary that has a Staff Hall of Fame inductee also has a plaque in their respective buildings.
